Malaysia's Limkokwing University Donates Rs.1.40 Million for the Flood Victims of Pakistan

The students of Limkokwing University of Malaysia representing 140 countries of the world, spearheaded by Pakistanis students, collected a donation of Rs.1.40 million for flood victims of Pakistan by various cultural, entertainment and bake-sale activities.

A mock cheque of Malaysian Ringgit 50,000/- (equivalent to Pak. Rs.1.40 million approx) was handed over by the Vice Chancellor of the Limkokwing University Dato' Parid Wardi to the Acting High Commissioner for Pakistan, Dr. Imtiaz A. Kazi, in a grand cultural and musical evening, attended by more than one thousand students, in Kuala Lumpur, yesterday (7th October, 2010).

Speaking on the occasion, Vice President of the University, Events & Special Projects Dato' Fajura Juffa said that the initiative to collect the donations for the flood victims of Pakistan was launched a month ago at the initiation of the Vice Chancellor of the University. During the fund raising campaign, titled, "Heal the World, Heal Pakistan", nine thousand students from 140 countries led by 160 Pakistani students organized various activities including charity bazaar, concerts, fashion show, on campus donation boxes, Pakistani food night and other such fund raising activities.

She said that collection of donation was a gesture of concern, care and sympathy strongly felt by the international students for their Pakistani brothers and sisters who have been affected by the unprecedented floods in Pakistan.

The Acting High Commissioner thanked the management of the University and the students for their enormous contribution towards the flood victims in Pakistan.

The student performed various cultural activities including a choice from Michael Jackson's "Let's heal the world". The Pakistani cultural dances, songs and dresses were the main attraction of the event.

Malaysians from all walks of life have been contributing both in cash and kind, as well as, sending various teams of relief workers and volunteers to Pakistan to render medical services, distribution of food products and other relief items in Pakistan.
