MIDA of Malaysia and BOI of Pakistan to Co-Organize a Seminar on Business

Malaysian Industrial Development Authority (MIDA) and Board of Investment (BOI) of Pakistan have agreed to jointly organize a seminar on “Business and Investment Opportunities in Pakistan”, in Kuala Lumpur on 31st March, 2010.

The Acting High Commissioner for Pakistan, Dr. Imtiaz A.
