Malaysian has Donated Mobile Utility Energy Package for Flood Affectees of Pakistan

Malaysia has donated a Mobile Utility Energy Package uniquely designed, engineered and pre-fabricated electrical power, air-conditioning and water filtration unit for the flood affectees of Pakistan. The unit has been provided by a Malaysian company Nomad Armada Sdn Bhd.

The unit, costing US\$1,80,000/- (Approximately Rs.15.48 million), weighing 11,000 Kg was handed over by the Deputy Foreign Minister of Malaysia, Senator A. Kohilan Pillay to the High Commissioner of Pakistan in Malaysia, Mr. Masood Khalid, in a ceremony held in Putrajaya on 24 March, 2011.

The ceremony was attended by a large number of diplomatic community, high government officials and media persons.

The High Commissioner for Pakistan while addressing the ceremony appreciated the goodwill gesture shown by the Malaysian side and said that this multipurpose unit will be deployed in the province of Sindh and would certainly help in providing electricity, safe drinking water, cooling and heating facilities to the flood affectees.

He also acknowledged with gratitude, the continuous gracious assistance provided by the government, corporate sector and people of Malaysia, both in cash and kind, since the super floods struck Pakistan in July last year.

The Managing Director of Nomad Armada Sdn Bhd, Mr. Hazmat Khan, and Executive Director of Dunham-Bush Holding Berhad while explaining the salient features of the plant said that this multipurpose unit can simultaneously be used for air conditioning, heating of water and provision of electricity. The unit equipped with 80 KW diesel driven generator with a total weight of 11000 kg can be used even in extreme weather conditions cold, hot or humid. Unit has established utility for providing cooling, heating, electricity and safe drinking water to mobile hospitals and schools in calamity hit areas.

Later the High Commissioner and the Deputy Foreign Minister witnessed the operation of the unit and expressed their satisfaction over its multipurpose utility.
