Deputy Prime Minister of Malaysia visited Pakistani Pavilion at 6th WIEF Exhibition.

The Deputy Prime Minister of Malaysia, Tan Sri Dato' Haji Muhyiddin bin Mohd. Yassin, visited the Pakistan Pavilion at the 6th World Islamic Economic Exhibition and appreciated the exhibits displayed there including Mangos, Handcrafts, pottery and leather products.

The Deputy Prime Minister who inaugurated the Business Women Forum and Youth Forum of the World Islamic Economic Forum (WIEF) today also opened the Exhibition in Kuala Lumpur. He spent some time at the Pakistan Pavilion, tasted and admired Pakistani Mangos and showed keen interest in the Pakistani traditional dresses included the bridal dress, folk dresses of the four provinces, embroidered cloths and leather products.

The custom made Pakistani Pavilion adorned with Pakistan Green colour remained a center of attraction for the visitors who thronged the pavilion all day long and appreciated the exhibits.

The Pakistani pavilion consists of four stalls. Showcasing mangos of Sindhri variety, pottery from Multan and Halla, leather products from Balochistan, and colorful Rilly from Sindh besides Pakistan ladies garments including the bridal dresses, table cloths and other varieties. The embroidery and patch work displayed is the labour done by the Women in Jails who have been imparted embroidery skills.

The display of Pakistan high quality traditional handicrafts and fruits in the exhibition will certainly introduce Pakistan products to thousands of visitors from global business community and Malaysian people.

A Pakistan delegation headed by Senator Waqar Ahmad Khan is arriving today to Kuala Lumpur Malaysia to represent Pakistan in the 6th World Islamic Economic Forum.
